**WHEREAS**, Tilden Project LLC (Applicant) has submitted an application (Application) to the Town of New Lebanon Planning Board (Planning Board) in connection with its efforts to develop the Tilden Commons project (the Project) at 538 Route 20 New Lebanon, New York 12125 (Tax Map ID 19.2-1-69) (Property) in the Town of New Lebanon, New York (Town), a copy of which Application, including the Full Environmental Assessment Form (FEAF Part I), is on file at the Town Hall and on the Town’s website; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 8 of the Environmental Conservation Law (SEQRA) and its implementing regulations, the Planning Board has indicated its intent to serve as Lead Agency with respect to the environmental review of the Project pursuant to SEQRA; and
