 INTERFUND LOAN RESOLUTION
 APRIL 14, 2026**

At the Regular Monthly Meeting of the New Lebanon Town Board, held at the New Lebanon Town Hall, 14755 NYS Route 22, New Lebanon, New York, duly called and held on the 14th day of April 2026, the following Resolution was proposed and seconded:

Interfund Loan Resolution

WHEREAS, the Town’s insurance policy is covering damages to the highway garage and the highway equipment caused by fire; and

WHEREAS, the Town has received payment for damages to the highway equipment and is still waiting on payment for damages to the highway garage; and

WHEREAS, there is work that needs to be done immediately on the highway garage to allow for the highway department to operate; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board previously adopted Budget Amendment Resolution #6 of 2026, but such resolution was adopted in error and should have been adopted as a temporary interfund advance pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 9-a;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Budget Amendment Resolution #6 of 2026 was passed in error on March 31, 2026 and is hereby rescinded; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Town Board hereby authorizes a temporary interfund advance pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 9-a in the amounts and to the accounts listed below and the general fund shall repay the highway fund in full no later than the close of the fiscal year.
